

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

In order to enroll your child(ren) to become a member of BGCSTL we must have the following:

- 1. Completed Membership Application
- 2. Child's Shot/Immunization Records
- 3. Birth Certificate (9 yrs. and under ONLY)
- 4. Proof of Income (one of the following):
 - Current tax return,
 - End of year paycheck stub,
 - Written notice from social service agency, not more than 30 days old
- 5. Special Care Plan (Asthma Plan, IEP, etc.)

Your child's application cannot be processed without these documents.

MEMBERSHIP

All youth participating in any program offered by Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater St. Louis must have a current membership. The annual membership fee is \$25 per child.

PROGRAM FEES

Some programs are included with annual membership. Other programs may have an additional one-time or reoccurring fee. Fees are subject to change without notice. The fees are shown below.

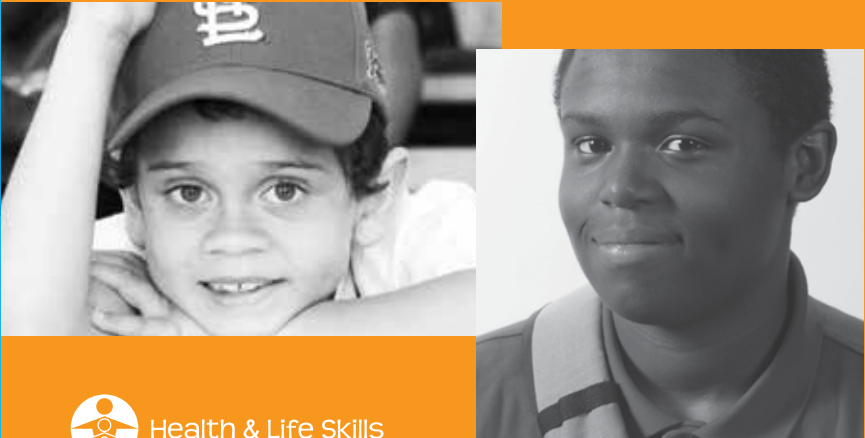
