
Zoo Hires Teens

Through this program, youth who complete our Junior Staff program are eligible to participate in Zoo-led workshops each February which can lead to summer employment with the St. Louis Zoo. This year twenty-four members ages 14-17 will have summer employment. Those who are successful are encouraged to work every summer for as long as they want. During the member's employment, BGCSTL staff conducts weekly check-ins and provides mentoring and the St. Louis Zoo pairs teens with work mentors to ensure success on the job. Zoo team member, Fred Falker, Director, Workforce Development & Training stated, "This is the best crop of kids we've had during our three year tenure with the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater St. Louis. They go above and beyond of what's expected of them, arrive early and come dressed to impress."
